8:00 - 12:00 **SSRS: Creating Dashboards and Widgets - Room 200**

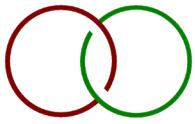

In this lab we will review our normal SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS) topics. This includes general information such as how to write a report, subscriptions, and snapshots. Additionally this lab will explore everything related to using an SSRS instance to write, publish, and consume SQL reports. Finally, we will take this basic knowledge and extend it by creating a company dashboard to display several key areas of the business such as Open AR, Open Orders, Inventory Turns, and Sales History. These Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) will be developed along the way. We will express these measures in a GUI dashboard with click-through, drill-down capability to show the detail behind each widget in the dashboard. This lab ultimately instructs users to present Manage 2000 data as KPIs using the native tools that are delivered with SSRS.

8:00 - 12:00 **Working with Json in M2k and UniData - Room 204**

Users will be introduced to techniques for working with Manage 2000 and UniData data in JavaScript Object Notation (JSON) format. JSON is an important data description object concept that is heavily utilized in modern APIs to transmit all forms of data. The usual issues in dealing with U2 and Manage 2000 data involve finding ways to mitigate the nested, multi-valued nature of the U2 database design. JSON handles the multi-dimensionality of U2 data as a native offshoot of its data object definition structure. This lab will be both an introductory and intermediate exploration for describing U2 data in JSON notation. Lab users will work with custom software programs to both produce and consume JSON data content and leave with usable programming examples to use in the real world.

Sometimes new development does not have to involve expensive developer and software investments in brand new software development kits (SDKs). There are times when wholly new graphical interfaces are necessary and then there are times when an existing user base simply needs a mode and method to update a SQL server data instance without introducing entire new application systems. In that regard, the Manage 2000 application development toolset is an extremely versatile, mature and stable application design framework. In a sense, the M2k toolset can be utilized as a Rapid Application Development (RAD) platform, which allows users to quickly flesh out a development project for user input to both M2k and SQL server. We will use this lab to model a basic Customer Relationship Management (CRM) development project to illustrate the power of M2k as a RAD when married with the NovoMotion real-time delivery to SQL on the back end of the database updates.

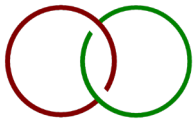

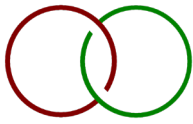

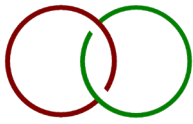

PRC is a software development life-cycle management tool written in and for your Epicor/U2 platform. This means that it manages upgrades, work that you do or have done to your system (customizations), and prevents your programmers from getting in each other's way. It includes a problem tracking system, resource/project management, source control (automatic), and deployment (with backups and recovery). Audit trail, reports and a clear, visible framework to see what your rules are and to show the auditors. Come learn (or learn more!) about what PRC can do for you.

Manage 2000 runs on a very versatile database called UniData. UniData is a multi-valued, nested database. 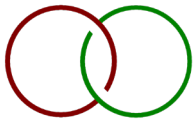

2. Portal (AWWebPortal): AWWebPortal will enable your Customers and Employees (on behalf of Customers) to view Real-Time M2K information via your web site. Sales Order Status, Shipment Information, Invoices/Statements, and RMA Tracking are all provided with AWWebPortal, which is written in .NET and works on Smartphones and Tablets as well.

3. Electronic Forms (AWForms): With AWForms your M2K System will be producing the most advanced and professional forms possible. Forms can be Emailed in PDF or Word formats, Printed, Automatically Archived, and/or faxed. Barcodes (39, 128, UPC, 2 Dimensional) on the Forms and Barcoded labels are a snap with AWForms. Looking to produce Customer Specific Labels - handled easily with AWForms.

4. Automatic Sales Tax (AWSalesTax). AWSalesTax fully automates the Sales Tax process for M2K. When entering Orders in M2K, AWSalesTax automatically creates the needed codes (with the correct percentages). AWSalesTax also re-verifies the rates at the time of Invoice. With AWSalesTax you don't need to pre-load or maintain any tables on your system because AWSalesTax uses Real-Time Web Services Technology to calculate the taxes.
